The cave of Trabuc is the most important underground network of the Cevennes. Situated in the periphery of the National Parc of Cevennes, every year thousands of spectators come to visit this beautiful cave.

A cave changes through the times. According to their age and the presence of oxydes the cristals are coloured. You will discover a wide range of differences over only a few metres.

July and August: guided tours at 10:15am/11am/11:45am/12:30pm/1:15pm/2pm and regular visit during the afternoon from 2pm to 6:30pm (last guided tour).
